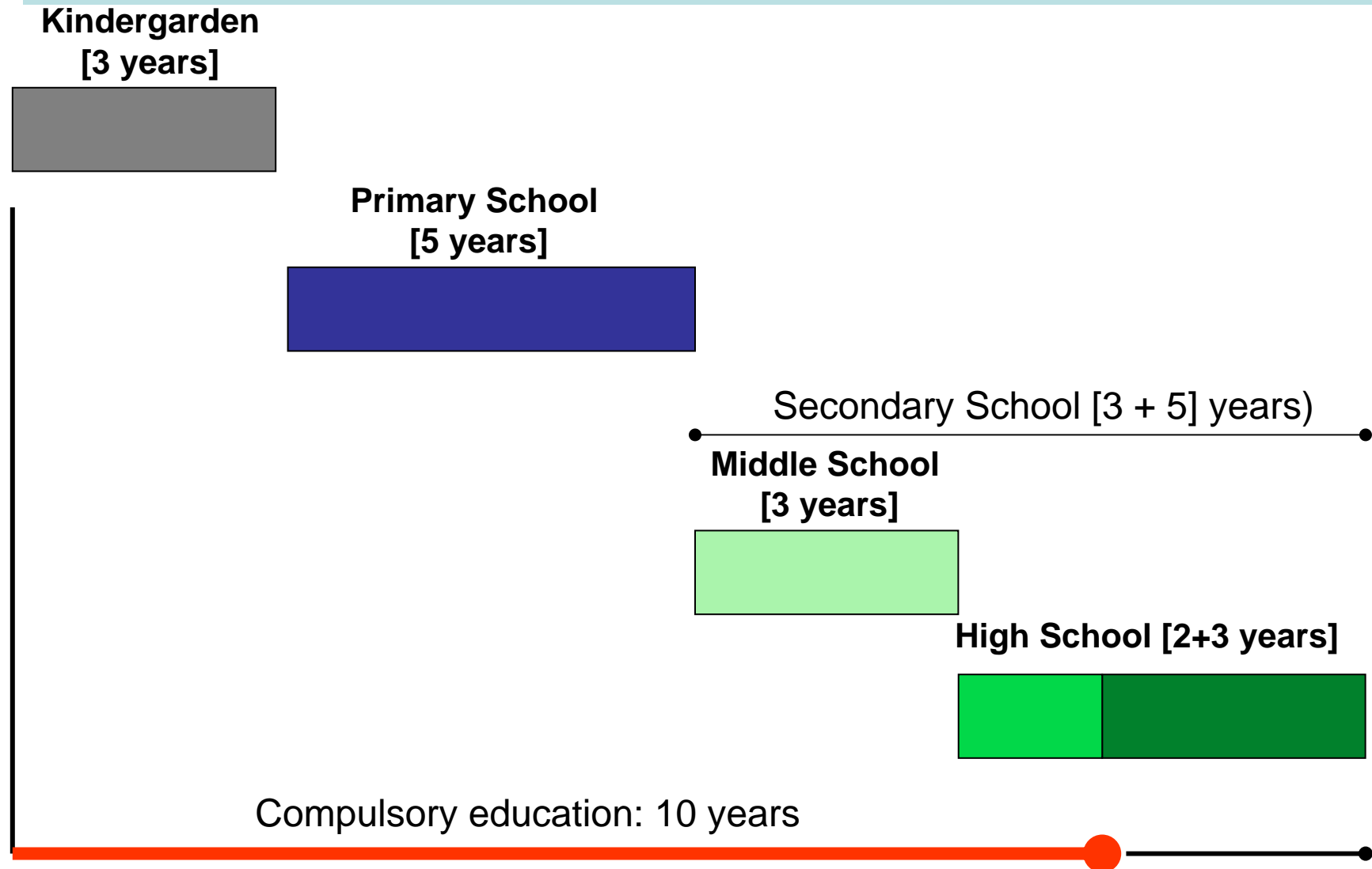

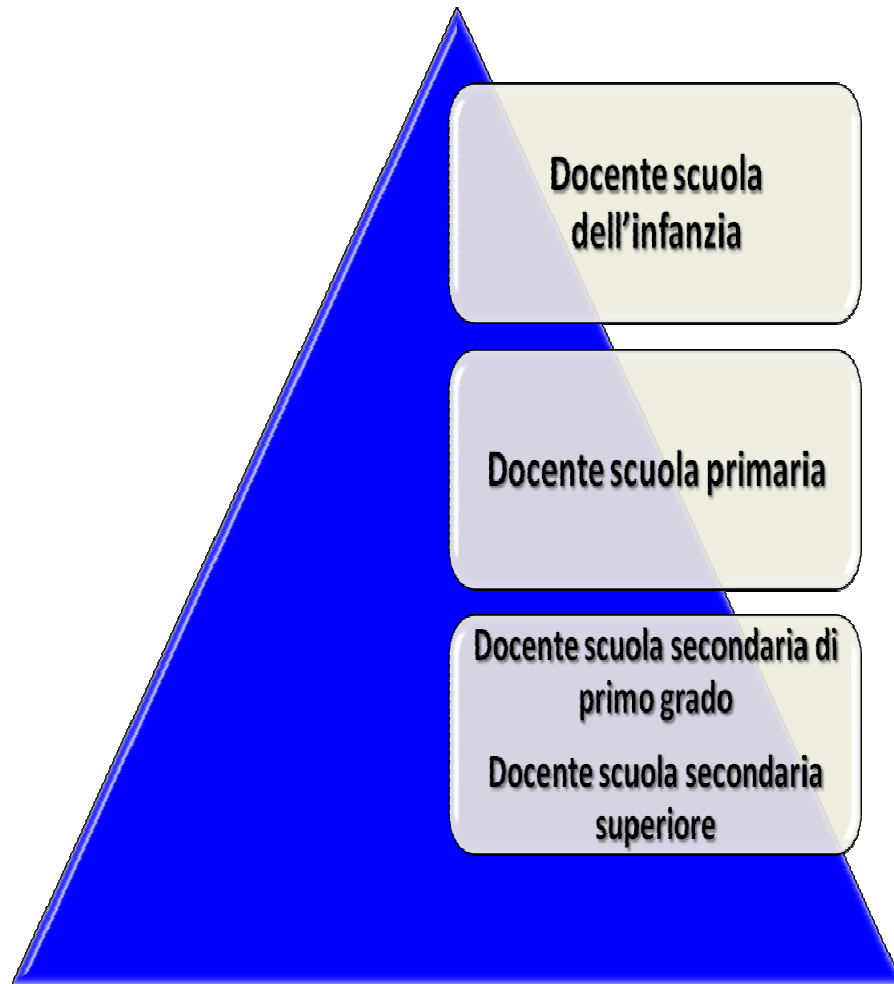

Teacher Certification in Italy

Kindergarten and Primary School

- B.A. (3) + M.A (2) [5 years]

Secondary School

- B.A (3) + M.A.(2) + 1 internship [6 years]

Foreign Languages at School

- Primary School : 1 (English)
- Middle School : 2 (English, French, Spanish, German)
- High School: 1-3 (English, French, Spanish, German, (Russian, Chinese)...))

CLIL at High School

- The new school reform states that at least one subject area will be taught in English

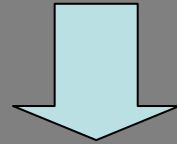

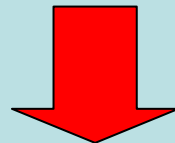

Earn a professional degree

**A Degree that allows to teach in
the country where it has been
earned as a certified teacher**

Recognition can be asked for

- **Subject area** where the teacher is certified

and

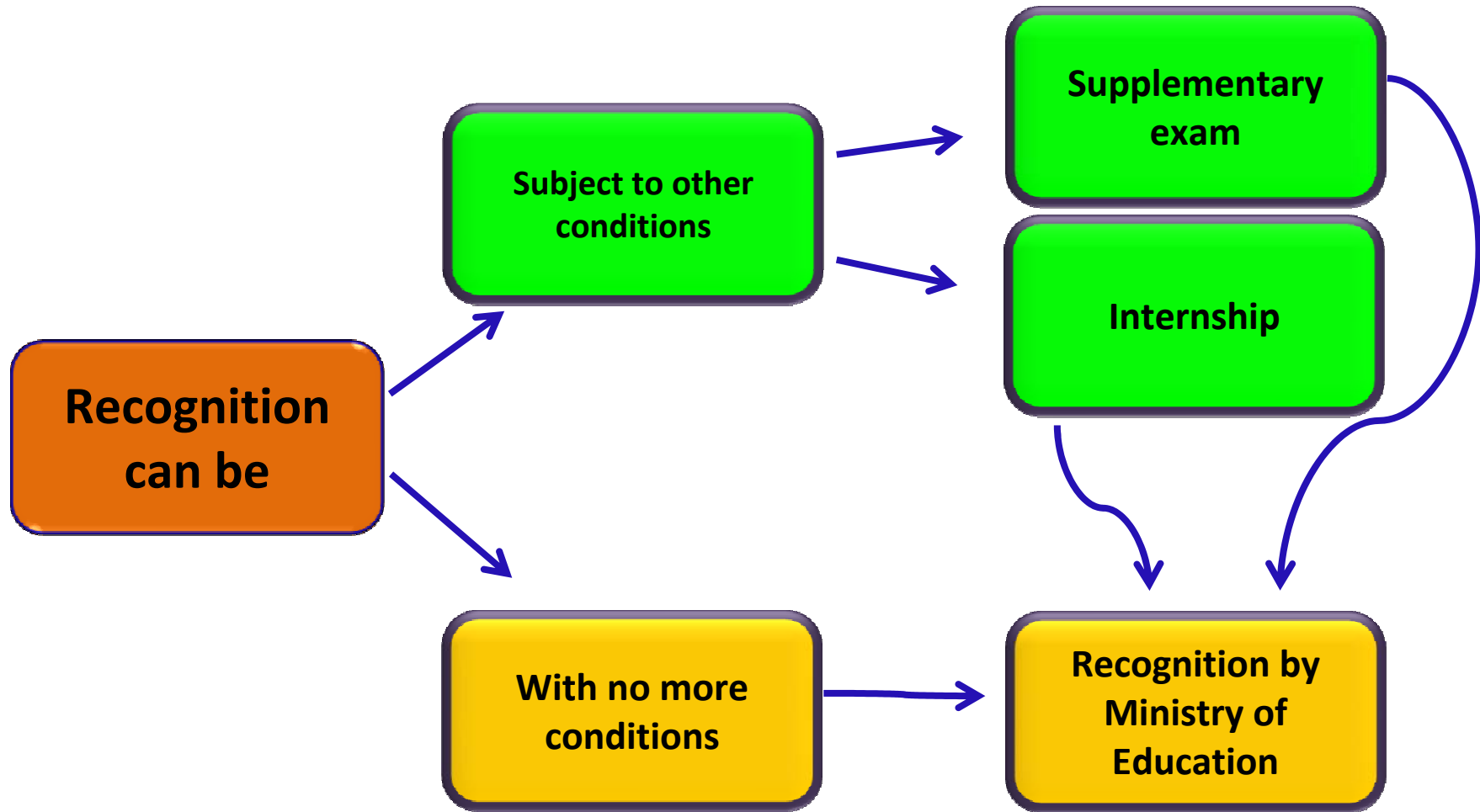
- if there is the same **subject area** in Italian School System

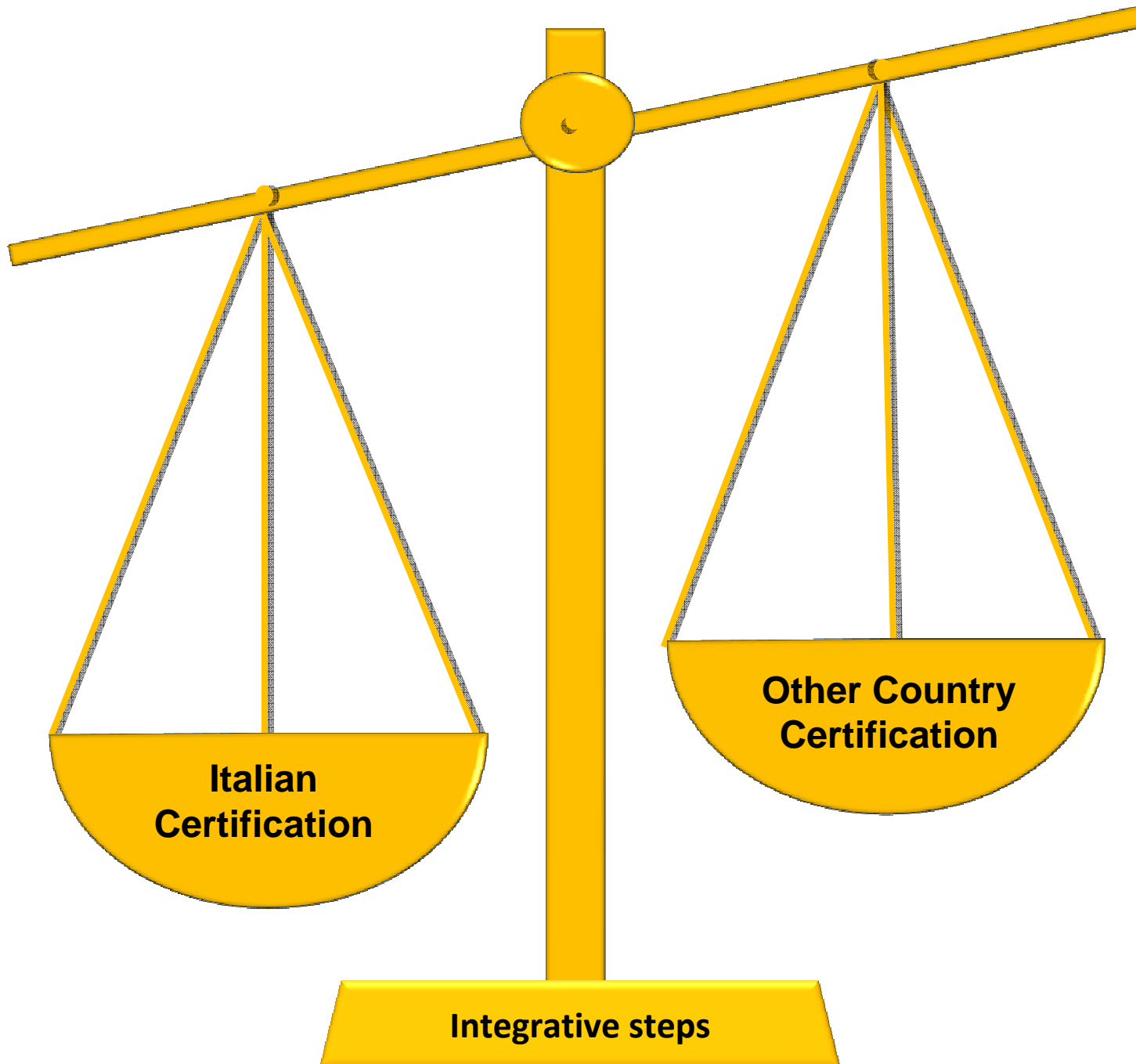
Documents

- (Visa)
 - College or University Degree
 - Certification Degree
 - (Recognition of certification (Consular Apostille))
 - Curriculum
 - Italian Language certification

- All the document must be officially translated

Language Certification

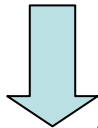
- certificazione “**CELI 5 Doc**” Università per Stranieri di Perugia
- certificazione “**CILS-DIT/C2**” Università per stranieri di Siena
- **Do NOT need a Language certification**
 - 12 years in Italian Schools
 - Italian Language or Literature B.A. Degree (abroad)
 - Italian B.A. Degree



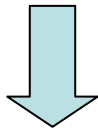

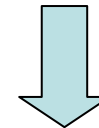

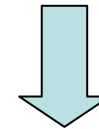
